Join Anne and Ridley Enslow for *Lafayette: Music for the Marquis* at the Bouman-Stickney Farmstead in the Wade-Wyckoff Barn. Explore the life of the Marquis de Lafayette, from his early years in the French court to his heroic role in the American Revolution.

The show alternates between captivating historical narrative and live musical performances on the violin and hammered dulcimer, featuring songs from the American and French Revolutions. This program honors the French-American hero and commemorates his return tour to the United States in 1824-25, which occurred at the invitation of President Monroe.
