NOTICE OF PENDING ORDINANCE AND SUMMARY

The ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the governing body of the Township of Readington, in the County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey, on March 4, 2024. It will be further considered for final passage, after public hearing thereon, at a meeting of the governing body to be held at the Municipal Building, in the Township on March 18, 2024 at 7:45 o'clock p.m. During the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of the full ordinance will be available at no cost and during regular business hours at the Clerk's office for the members of the general public who shall request the same. The summary of the terms of such ordinance follows:

Title: ORDINANCE REAPPROPRIATING \$21,332 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOR THE ACQUISITION OF A BREATHALYZER IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF READINGTON, IN THE COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, NEW JERSEY – Ordinance #09-2024

Purpose: To reappropriate \$21,332 of the \$40,000 appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund by Ordinance #08-2021, finally adopted May 3, 2021, in order to provide for the acquisition of a breathalyzer, including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto.
